



## **ECHOS FROM THE COUNCIL OF THE MRC DU HAUT-SAINT-LAURENT**

### **Regular Meeting of May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

#### **REVISED LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN (SAD)**

The Council of the MRC du Haut-Saint-Laurent approved the following requests for compliance of by-laws as they do not contravene the objectives of the revised land use and development plan nor the provisions of the complementary document:

- N<sup>os</sup> 375-6, 378-16, 378-17, 379-4, 380-5, 381-3 and 376-13 of the municipality of Hinchinbrooke amending the by-laws relating to land use planning, zoning, subdivision, construction, internal governance and permits, and the general development plan;
- N<sup>os</sup> 2003-05-33, 2003-06-09, 2003-08-12 and 2017-07 of the municipality of Sainte-Barbe amending the by-laws relating to zoning, subdivision, permits and certificates, the general development plan and site planning and architectural integration plans;
- N<sup>o</sup> 367 of the municipality of Franklin regarding the storage of agri-food products.

#### **SUPPORT**

The mayors resolved to support the following organisations:

- the Rural Arts Project and to offer 1 600 \$ in services under the Arts Alive Festival 2017;
- the MRC des Maskoutains regarding its request to the Minister of Public Safety to do what is necessary to come to an agreement with the MRC regarding training programs for its firefighters and officers;
- the municipality of Elgin relating to its request to the Ministry of Transport, Urban Mobility and Electrification of Transportation of Quebec to review its decision to exclude winter maintenance expenses under the Maintenance Assistance Program of Local Road Networks (PAERRL).

#### **CONTRACTS/AGREEMENTS**

The mayors awarded the following contracts:

- Mowing of the regional linear park for 2017 to *Les Entreprises N Théorêt*, in the sum of 24 978,84 \$;
- Contract for external auditor services for the financial years 2017, 2018 and 2019 to *Goudreau Poirier inc*, at a cost of 34 147,58 \$;
- An agreement focusing on heritage, financed through partnerships with:

the Ministry of Culture and Communications :	60 000 \$
the MRC du Haut-Saint-Laurent :	82 000 \$
University of Montreal (Archaeological Field School):	<u>45 000 \$</u>
TOTAL :	187 000 \$
