Regular session of October 11th, 2017

FOLLOW-UP OF THE LAND USE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN

By-law 299-2017 was adopted; it amends the revised land use planning and development plan by adding exceptions to the application of conditions for the issuance of building permits for landlocked lots under the cadastral reform.

CONTRACTS

The mayors resolved to renew the following contracts:

- with Rebutts Solides Canadiens Inc. for the pick-up, sorting and packing of all collected recyclable materials, in the approximate amount of 41 273,12 \$, including taxes, for 2018.
- with Robert Daoust & Fils Inc., for the collection, transportation, treatment and marketing of recyclable materials, with the addition of the municipality of Elgin, in the approximate amount of 239 966,47 \$, including taxes, for 2018.

VARIA

The mayors resolved to support the following organizations:

- the MRC d'Avignon in its request to the Ministry for Forests, Wildlife and Parks for the renewal of the Sustainable Forest Management program whereby the spins-offs from this program are significant to regions where forests are a large part of the economy.
- the International Narrative Short Film Festival (FICMAN-INSFF) for 2018, through a contribution of 1 500 \$ in services, mainly in the form of assistance with promotion.
